a) HHPS would like the P&C to fund:

- High-level interest readers for K-2 and 3-6, to be used in classrooms to support the school’s literacy program - **\$15,000** – *SP to advise NKA & give her a sample to promote books at Grandparents day (try to get Grandparents to donate monies for books. Other options for books is fundraising via Go Fund me page.*
- Integration of more iPads into teaching and learning, 2 class sets (60x\$500) - **\$30,000** – *Concerns were raised about the amount of screen time children have. Committee voted all committee members voted No.*
- Positive reinforcement strategies used by teachers by supplying teachers with stamps and stickers \$100 per teacher (30 teachers) **\$3,000** – *P&C approved sticker spend of up to \$3k*
- Raise an additional **\$40,000** to purchase the necessary equipment to complete the 3-6 playground. At the last building committee meeting it was determined that we are likely to be short \$40,000 – \$50,000, which would be the climbing equipment. The tendering process is happening and will proceed as planned. The equipment may then need to be installed at a later date.
